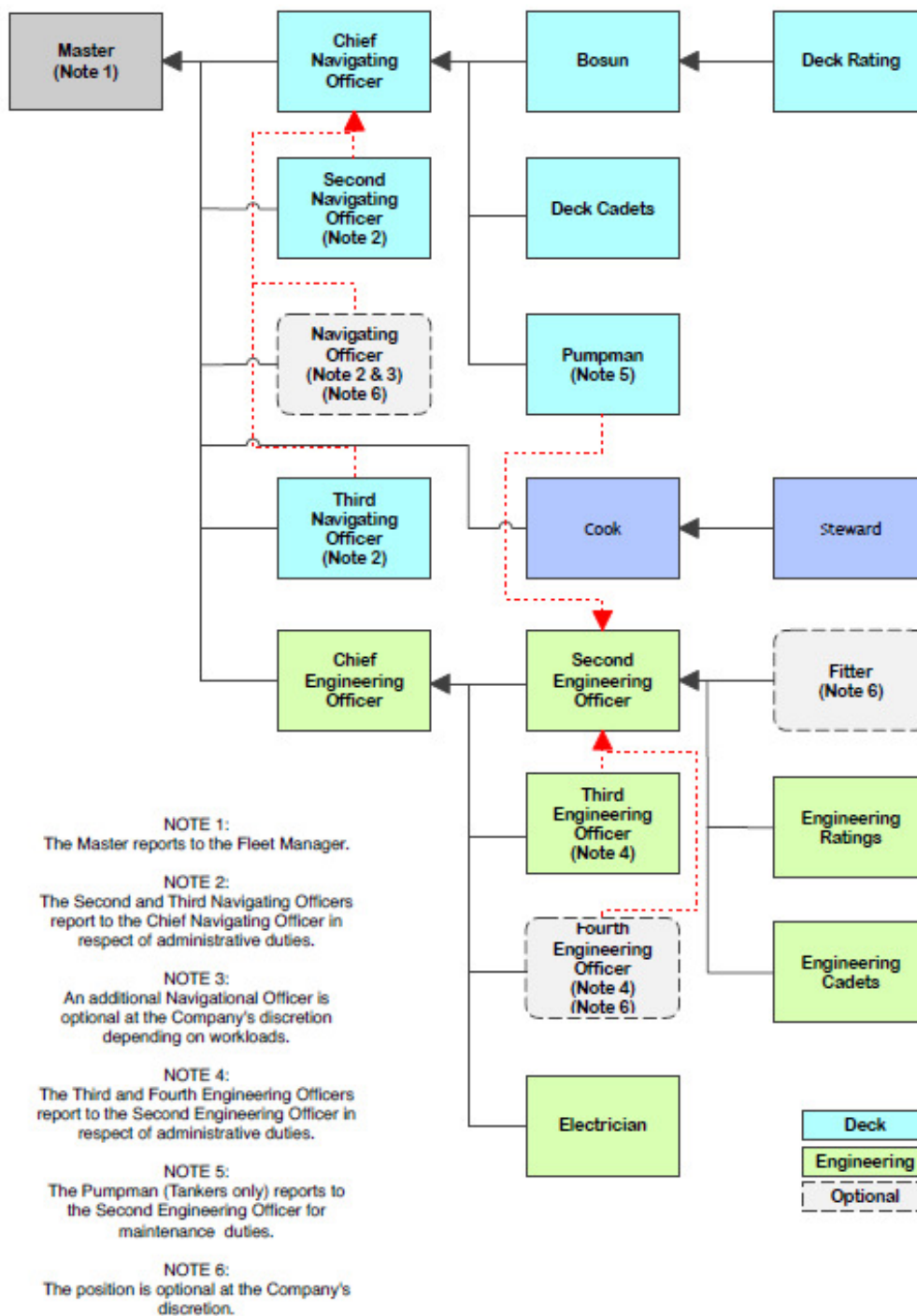

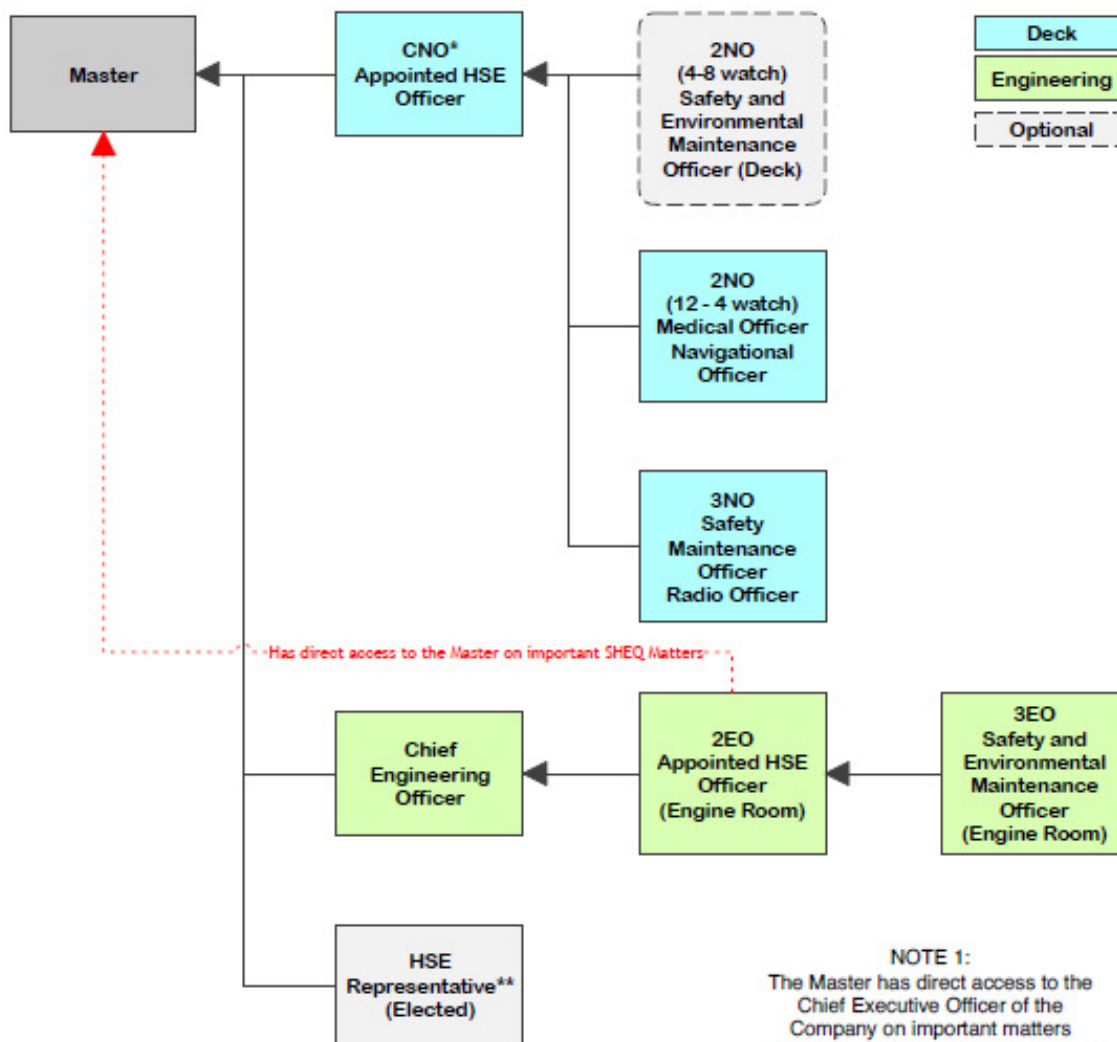
1. VESSEL² OPERATIONAL ORGANISATION

NOTE 1:

The Master has direct access to the Chief Executive Officer of the Company on important matters concerning safety and environmental protection; however, this is normally through the Designated Person Ashore

NOTE:

Additional Navigating Officers is optional at the Company's discretion depending on workloads. When not carried his/her responsibilities are shared between the other navigating officers at the Masters discretion. This equally applies to other ranks

*Master and CNO may be appointed as HSE Officer (Deck) and SSO, however, this role is usually carried out by the CNO.

**The number of elected HSE representatives is stipulated in COSWOP dependent on the size of the vessel.
