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TECHNICAL PROCEDURES MANUAL

1. GENERAL

The Technical Procedures Manual is an integral part of the third tier of the integrated Safety, Health, Environmental and Quality Management System.

It incorporates Circulars used for the quick dissemination of instructions that take precedence over or amplify those contained in the Technical Procedures Manual.

Refer to Fleet Procedures Manual (2.0. SAFETY, HEALTH, ENVIRONMENT AND QUALITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM) – Section 7 for further details on company circulars.

The technical bulletins are saved on the landing page of the SMS under “Vessel Engine Technical circulars”. It comprises of sections for the main engines and the generators. New technical info is received by the shore management team, then shared with the fleet issuing a Technical Circular with the makers bulletin attached. The document is then filed into the relevant folders in the SMS. Ships staff are to sign and file the signed doc in the training folder with the OJT records.¹
