Enclosed please find updated NRC WA Plan Notification Placard and Field Guide documents which should be posted on board your vessels in a visible and accessible location while the vessel is in Washington State waters. Please note Washington Department of Ecology (WDOE) field inspectors may board your vessel and hold a notification drill at any time while your vessel is in Washington State waters. The WDOE requires the attached Notification Placard and Field Guide document to be readily accessible to the crew, otherwise the WDOE may levy a civil penalty fine. For easy access and quick reference, NRC recommends the NRC WA Plan Notification Placard and Field Guide document be placed inside the front cover of your vessel's Federal Vessel Response Plan should an emergency or incident occur.
