Anchorage approach	Vessel initially approach from the west, passing south of lle de Re and north of lle d Óleron. Vessel which do not receive berthing instruction on arrvl should wait at anchor in the vicinity of 0.5-1.0nm south of Chauveau buoy.
Min. depth at anchorage/Channel	Minimum depth at anchorage is 15.4m / Minimum depth at channel is 11.6m.
Pilot performance/Tugs condition Other information	Compulsory (available 24 hours) from Chauveau Buoy and for all vessels greater than LOA 55 m. Pilot launch meets vessels at Chauveau Buoy in position Lat. 46° 06' 05" N,Long. 001° 16' W. Contact Pilot via VHF Channels 16 and 12, 12 hours and further confirmation 2 hours before arrival. Two tugs of 30 tonnes BP are permanently stationed at La Pallice with a third tug of 22 tonnes BP available with 48 hours' notice. Tugs will join vessels in the approaches to the port, tugs' lines are usually used.

Quay Lombard (290m in length) with 13.0m Dredge depth Dry bulk is handled using two gantry cranes (400 and 1,000 tonnes/hr. capacity) linking to a single conveyor system. SICA Atlantique storage
